Hi, I'm Mark Sausser Stream Habitat Manager with PFBC. We are working with Loyalhanna Watershed Association(LWA), and Western Pennsylvania Conservancy(WPC) on improving stream habitat in Loyalhanna Creek. PFBC designs and oversees construction of all the habitat devices installed. The sites we have completed so far along route 30 have totaled 2000 feet upstream and downstream of peters road bridge. The property is open to the public for fishing as long as you stay along stream bank. Property is owned by Laurel Valley Golf Club and Seton Hill. Funding was awared to LWA provided by Richard King Mellon Foundation. Work will continue on improving another 2400' this summer located on the boundry line of rolling rock property downstream to Ligoner Beach. LWA is attempting to secure funding from The Mellon Foundation for another 1.5 miles of stream improvement for Loyalhanna. Support and praise is very welcomed and thank you.
