Hi Evofly,

Welcome to the Paff forums and our online community. If you haven't already noticed, we have a Beginner's Forum where fly fishing (FFing) newbies can ask questions or seek advice.

With respect to Wallenpaupack - I'm not from that part of the state and don't regularly fish it so can't offer specific spots. Oftentimes, in larger lakes and impoundments, fish tend to be deep this time of year. However, early morning or late evening can see fish a bit shallower. I'd try fishing a small popper around shoreline cover like fallen trees or lilly pads. This ought to get some sunfish or small bass. A pair of bead head or weighted nymphs fished deeper under a strike indicator might work too and would be more likely to get you some crappies or perch. Trout are probably too deep to chase with FFing gear.... but you should be able to find panfish and they're great fun on a fly rod.
