Sounds like the last rain didn't do as much as we thought it would, but in the next week or so, the night time temperatures will drop into the 40s, and most days the daytime temperatures won't exceed 70. Also, rain is forecasted, multiple times. The good news is that fish are being caught at the mouths of the creeks, and the boats have been reporting a good year, so once the fish can get up into the creeks, it should be a really good year.
