Penns is a tough nut to crack at any time of the year. The fish are there. But they turn on and off quickly and completely, and the guy who plays with the switch must be an eccentric old coot. Just very hard to predict, so while I'll give my plan A, keep in mind that I often end up on plan E or F on Penns, lol.

But I'd probably start by planning to deep nymph the fast water. Biggish nymphs, say, maybe stoneflies or iso's. Find heavy riffes, put on lots of weight, and have at it.
