Me personally, if I'm covering water I found them to be limiting...(I used indicators mainly for nymphing) and I would be interested in your thoughts on using them from it acting as an indicator for nymphing (i found you can't fish deep enough) to dry fly presentations - all in the same leader or are you changing based on different water / presentation.

I would love to find a way to not have to change leaders to go from nymphing (dead drifting deep, not swinging) to dry flies. It would be cool if it was just a few knots to tie on a new tippet section.
