The wind was blowing so I had to use my 8 wt used a olive wb and a #12 prince as a dropper. Would cast out into as deep as water as I could reach let everything sink for 10-15 seconds then do a very slow retrieve just bumping it along and hits just kept coming. I had 2 bluegill double headers!

Lots of fun may try again today if I can get out.
