Bottom release dams are a big question mark. I think that unless there stocked below the numbers are not in your favor. Surviving the depth change is the problem. Kinzua dam and the tailout and the allegheny is open all winter and is your safest bet. I've yet to hook a musky in winter but have caught pike in just about every month of the year. They seem to stay more active. But musky have to eat and when they do it a BIG meal. Good luck too ya. And by the way trout are "scooby snacks" for toothies!
