I've fished it a few times.....over thirty years ago when I lived in Maryland. I can recall getting wild browns and that the stream was very brushy and rather low gradient. They used to stock the section further down between the reservoirs but I only recall getting wild fish up in the reg section. Honestly, I think prospecting for trout this time of year is a rather low success endeavor. I'd rather stick to waters I know well in the late fall and winter. With that said, if I was going to hit this stream, I'd wait for a sunny afternoon and focus on the deepest pools. If no fish can be seen midging on top, I'd dredge the bottom with a small egg fly/nymph combo.
