I'd love to see a private org really attack this. Perhaps too risky for an individual, but do-able by a group.

Organize, publicize a list like this, and state that your going after all posted signs on waters on the list. You start with 1 or 2, do a fish-in or whatever, take it to court, and if you win, you get more support, and I think signs start coming down without a battle.

The risk is that you win these streams, but by starting a war you lose others not on the list. It would happen in places, but IMO, to a lesser degree than is feared. I think you gain more than you lose.
