Even in the summer would get tons of mayflies and caddis plastered to your windshield just at dark. Numbers of scuds in the weedbeds (where are they now?) was amazing. I think scuds were the big food source, but the bugs provided more fun fishing.

I hate to post numbers because they seem to cause a lot of bickering, but up through the 1990's a typical afternoon of easy fishing could yield 20 or so fish. Always could find a fish feeding, and usually on top. That sort of fishing is in the past.

Also, back in the day the Saucon was a dead conduit for zinc mine drainage. There have been puts and takes - but mostly fishing has been heading down since about 2000.
