Chaz is right that the thread color is not the standard used on this pattern, but given the same pattern catches fish with various colored balls on its head makes me believe that it is not important. That thread looks like a light brown or tan which is a pretty versatile color for tying. If you are really worried about it, you could always run a sharpie on the last few inches before whip finishing to change the color. I rarely use anything but 8/0 light tan or 8/0 black. I've got a ton of other colors, but for most trout flies tied to fish, those two do the job.
