The F. Halford, angler and author, often recognized as "The father of modern dry fly fishing" devoted most of his entire life searching, writing, and fly-fishing the dry fly.

He wrote seven books about the subject, this includes Dry Fly Fishing in Theory and Practice, Modern Development of the Dry Fly, and his *Tour de Force*, Dry Fly Entomology.

Print and engravings of the book surprise me; they are absolutely superb and exceed most of the modern fly-fishing publishers work.

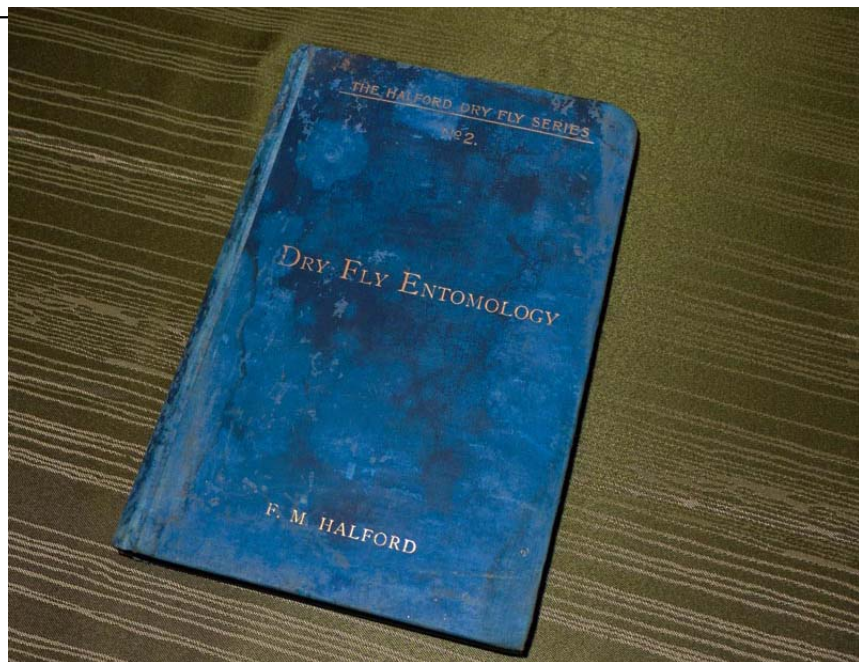
You can see this on some plates I photographed.
