I subscribe to and highly recommend American Angler (it's purely a fly-fishing magazine) because of its nice variety of features, columns, and photos. I also subscribe to Fly Rod & Reel; it is only a step below AA. I often buy Flyfishing and Tying Journal off magazine racks, and I like it, too, though its slant is more toward Western anglers than us Easterners. I receive Fly Fisherman magazine as a gift subscription, and I agree that it has deteriorated badly over the years, now being mainly a kiss-and-tell journal. It did, however, include a nice feature on the late George Harvey in its last issue; maybe Ross Purnell get get its content straightened out. Fish & Fly is also a destination magazine; I seldom ever pick it off a rack.
