I'm not exactly sure what you mean by "fishable". I'm pretty sure if you give your pattern a fair chance you will catch fish, they have a good look.

When I think of a swimming nymph I lean more toward a little bit of flash and a **whole lot of movement**. Here are some I tied using the Clouser Swimming Nymph pattern. I tied these flies mainly for carp fishing this summer. Plop one down into the silt 5 or 6 feet in front of a muddin' carp (without spooking it). Wait until they approach it and suck it in! Time it just right and, Yeehaaa!!!
