Groundhog day and it's snowing outside! I've been looking at this pack of 22's and the smallest tungsten beads they make! They have been sitting on my desk for a couple months! LOL

Last winter I was catchin' winter trout pretty good on tiny zebra midges....

No problem, I'll see if my camera works with closeup shots! And no flash, just my vise light? First "tie" test:



The hardest part was getting the tiny beads on the size 22 hooks.



I used 6/0 black thread and tied in some gold micro wire.



Wire wrapped to bead and whip finished.



I tied in one strand of Peacock Hurl



Two wraps, whip finish again, and a drop of Sally Hansen Hard  
as Nails only on the bottom part... none on the Peacock.
