This post showed up in my google alerts, so I thought I would join in. I live in Boise and the Owyhee is awesome in September. Bring plenty of hoppers and zebra midges for droppers - 4x or 5x flourocarbon tippet will usually do the trick. Streamer fishing can also get you into same good fish, especially late in the moth when some of the big browns are gearing up to spawn. I typically start all the way up at the dam (park at the picnic area and walk in a few hundred yards) and work my way down.
