Anyway, with that said - by all means try that section. Muskie guys are tight lipped about their favorite spots, but what you describe sounds good and river muskies bite year round, although I wouldn't bother if the river is icy. The Swatara was (and is) stocked with tigers. Prospecting with spin gear is a good idea and will allow you to cover more water. Just remember, if you always wanted to catch one on a fly..... Just be prepared to pay your dues. Nothing wrong with a sore shoulder.
