Saw some carp in it, but it didn't look very Trouty to me. Never fished it, but I remember seeing some guys fishing it from the far bank (not on golf course property) in the Spring. Considering the volume of the music, the size of the coolers, and the pile of beer cans, I'm not exactly sure how much actual fishing they were doing though.

Given its location and watershed I would think its capacity for holding over Trout is rather minimal as Maurice mentioned. Probably fishes halfway decent after Spring stockings like most ATW's though. FWIW, in warmer weather the main stem of Chartiers below the confluence with Little Chartiers is a half decent Smallie stream.
