Wetboot, it happens to all of us. I have been FF for 41 yrs. Last March I took a good friend of mine trout fishing. He is a newbie. He caught 15 fish and I caught 1. Oh well. It happens. At this time of year and early Spring I would recomend trying some small nymphs. size 16 or 18 pheasant tails or Hairs ear. The Hairs ear has been around forever and always produces. I know you said you are not sure what that is. Just google it. Or even better if you have a local fly shop. Stop by and ask for help. Most guys at fly shops are very helpful and should be able to give some good advice. As some of the other guys mentioned Winter fishing can be tough. Especially when temps are changing. I usually do not go on that 1st nice day. Which seems like the thing to do. But it usually means snow melt. Snow melt adds cold water to the stream and makes for sluggish fish. Keep up your hard work and good luck.
