Yeah, maybe that could work. Also, the LL is great, you just have to get there before everyone else so you can cover the most water possible. Euro nymphing is much harder to get a hang of, but once you start to get it, it can be more effective than indicator nymphing.

Indicator fishing has its place. However, high sticking is really more productive. My friend that was fishing the water first was indicator nymphing and using the same flies as me, he caught the skunk. He is looking now for a 10ft+ rod and wants to learn the high sticking method. He has become a believer.

Becker, you should really not make a blanket statement like "high sticking is really more productive". It is a very productive way to fly fish but fishing with an indicator can be just as productive under the right circumstances. I fish either way depending on conditions. Take my advice and don't get in the rut of only fishing one way. By using different methods you will catch more trout. I know, I learned that the hard way, thru experience. 😊
