On a calm day, can I expect to cast into the wash where the baitfish are? We're usually only talking 30 or 40 feet, right?

Right.

Often, if the fish are truly in "the wash" you're not even casting that far - the fish are right at your feet in the suds. I've even had days where I was standing in the wash with waves flowing back out into the surf and feeding stripers and blues were further up the beach than where I was standing in water just inches deep and their dorsals were protruding as they chased bait. Just keep in mind, days like this are very rare and are the stuff dreams and videos are made of. In reality, most days the fish are out under the breakers out of sight (if they're around at all) and you will be blind casting with wind.
