Foxgap: "Anyway, Echo Carbon is closing out last year's model's and I saw their 6'6" 3wt rod on sale for \$127.99. Usually \$170 or \$180. Of course, if you have a friend who is cleaning out his stock, you can get it for much less."

The OP asked about a 4wt and the 3 wt echo should be great brookie rod with a 4w line. ... A 3wt rod is made to cast the weighit of approx 30 ft of 3 wt line. For shorter casting, a heavier line is better; 25 ft of 4 wt line weighs about as much as 30 ft of 3 wt line. And you might cast 25 ft for brookies, Foxgap, if you stand as far back as possible to avoid spooking the fish!

Agreed but I took the word "under" as relating to both lenght and weight. I certainly could be wrong. Although I planned on trying a 4 wt first......hmmm, I would say great minds think alike but that would assume I even have a mind!
