Chaz, strange because I catch the crap out of trout on the Delaware using really heavily collared comparduns, Catskill style and also klinkhammer style flies. I guess those trout don't know any better.

In faster broken water, sparsely collared flies will sink. Look at the Wolff style flies - those have huge collars and were specifically tied to be fished in faster, broken water and guess what, they work.

Sparse collared flies work well in slower, flat, clear water while heavily collared ones work better in faster, broken and maybe off-colored water and you know what, there may even be some exceptions to this general rule.
