The apps do work on tablets. They are really designed for devices with GPS receivers. In the Apple world, WiFi iPads do not have these receivers but 3G/4G iPads do. If you pay a phone provider a monthly fee to connect your tablet, it should have a GPS. It's basically the same in Android. It's all dependent on the actual model of the device and whether it's connected or Wifi.

If you load the app on a non-GPS device, it still works but you can't use it for effective navigation which is the real cornerstone of the app. You can still get directions and routing but it won't follow you turn-by-turn.
