Periodically, I read the reviews on the web hoping something better would be out there...but, have not felt the need to throw money away. The marketing hype suggests vast improvements with each new model...but, I have not seen it when I have tried them. It seems that the buttons have also become more difficult and less intuitive with each improvement. The low light scenarios and amount of detail captured can be better. I find myself color correcting any images I take (occupational hazard).

As already mentioned by others, the ability to take your iPhone (in a Lifeproof case) along is a great addition...but more for the smart phone than the camera.

I find myself in a hurry to release a fish and sometimes take photos with both when I do not see ideal results. Many times I am by myself...which creates a rough time documenting holding a large fish. Having a buddy to capture that moment continuously yields better results.
