I think Chaz was kidding about sharks. They're all over the Keys (mostly nurse, lemons, bonnets and blacktips) but they're really no threat. I never worried about 'em and enjoy fishing for them. Just be aware that if you catch one, don't try to hoist 'em by the tail salmon style - they can twist around and bite like a snake. However, if you see 'em on the flats, it's usually nothing to worry about as they aren't generally aggressive. What you really do have to be careful of are stingrays if you're wading. Shuffle your feet so you kick 'em rather than stepping and pinning 'em (if you pin one, you will be hating life and your fishing will be over for the rest of the trip - and probably much walking - very serious injury).

Actually I wasn't kidding, there are sharks and the most dangerous is the Bull Shark, and they have them in spades. While fishing Biscayne Bay and the Fla. Bay I saw them.
