May here in PA as the weather is great, fish are active and willing to take flies in multiple presentations. And the water is still cool, making more streams and spots available to fish compared to June. In Wyoming, on the North Platte, definitely August. I am lucky enough to go for a week every year to twelve miles of private water on the North Platte and its tribs. That is big fish country out there. Not uncommon to have one out of every ten fish twenty plus. The Articulated Streamer, Nymphing and Trico fishing is the best I have ever seen. Eighty plus fish days between two people is normal.
