That is the case with some streams in some other coal mining districts. In these places there are mine discharges that provide a steady baseflow of cold water, and luckily the pH, and metals content, is not too bad, so the mine discharge actually helps maintain the trout fishery.

If it is the case that mine discharge is sustaining the trout fishery, it's good for all involved to know it. Any plans to change the mine water systems should take that into account.
