strike 23: The only "control" that we have seen that is effective in managing white perch populations is a naturally occurring fish kill, per Nockamixon Lake in 1985-1986. Gizzard shad periodically have naturally occurring fish kills during or just after the winter as energy reserves are depleted and vulnerability to diseases increases. Those populations in all cases we've seen quickly bounce back within a year.
