I fish Maryland a good bit and almost never see PA, DC or NJ plates when I'm down there. Up here in PA, on both trout streams and warm water locations (including Codorus SP) I see quite a few MD, DC and NJ plates. I can think of dozens of "good" places to fish WW fishes just here in SC PA (and that's without the Susky anymore).

I'm not a weekly regular on Marburg but I've fished it for over thirty years. Sure, the walleyes and yellow perch aren't what I remember them to be, but other game fish more than make up for it in my view. And yes the white perch can be tough to find in summer (like most fish in the lake) but I think they're pretty easy to catch when you find 'em.

You really seem to be down on Marburg.....to each his own.

I like it and believe, all things considered, it's better than 10 or 20 years ago.
