I have taken some painful impacts to my knees and shins in brookie fishing, and tried these "shift enforcer" knee / shin guards (\$15/ pair at motorcycle shop). The knee guards werent tall enough for even me (5'8") so I cut them and have a nifty pair of shin guards, strong stay put, 5 oz each. The foam backing is perforated, so I will try wearing them under waders some time.. they worked very well over waders on a rough rocky-stream brookie bash yesterday... stayed put and so light I that forgot about them right away.
