This is a redington pursuit in 5 wt with a Risen 5/6 wt Ichthus reel.

I have a lot of luck with this rod and casting heavier rigs, it is a pretty fast action. I am mainly roll casting however.

The leader set up for this day was 6' 20# stren, 2' suffix high viz yellow in 14# and 5' of suffix 6# flouro with about 16" of tag for my anchor fly so about 13-14'. I am shortening this up a bit, however for my new leaders I am tying. I am still playing with this but I think I may try to keep the leader a bit smaller.

I never go with any line smaller than 6# flouro until summer. I have never had anything bad to say about suffix flouro. I will say that if you have the money go with Seagar but for the budge fisherman like my self, I buy the 13.00 suffix and repool old leader spools with it. If it ain't broke dont fix it.
