More often, the idea is that, rather than just drifting it into an unknowing fish's mouth, the fish actually, you know, mistakes it for a food item and intentionally eats it. A bead makes a good imitation of a single egg. Most of our egg flies, even smallish glo bugs, are a little big to represent a single trout egg.

You can put beads right on a hook, just like you can put a hookless fly up the line. Thus the Moffitt system is a separate discussion from beads. I was answering to the beads only, not the Moffitt system.
