Now have the Fly Racing Flex II integrated dirt-bike knee-shin guards. These motocross knee/shin guards were made to wear above riding boots and under riding pants, not that different from using them with wading boots and waders, I guess.

The Flex IIs are taller and fit me better than the Shift models, and the knee plate is easy to walk in (knee plate has no strap behind it and floats in front of my knee with little rubbing). I can imagine wearing the Flex IIs over waders or under them (tragically concealing the cool bird logos). A nicely made product for \$22/pair.

The Flex IIs have the shin and knee plates in a straight line, rather than having the knee plate curve in toward the user, as on the Shifts. The Flex ones seem better for walking.
