If you're limited to VA or private water isn't your cup of tea, I'll second the suggestion to contact the folks at Mossy Creek. Mossy is a valley limestone and is located in the Shenandoah Valley, which is also where the Shenandoah River flows. If you' prefer a mountain freestone experience it really is hard to beat Shenandoah National Park, which is really not the valley but rather the Blue Ridge mountains on the east border of the valley.
