I have gone as light as a 1 wt(don't recommend that, it is like latching on a freight train!! Heck of a blast!!) I would say a 7 wt is ideal on bigger waters. I don't like the 10' single hand, a 9 1/2', I feel less is better and easier on the arm. Over 10 give me a switch or a spay much easier casting over the course of a day. 10" and over are also a bit more difficult getting the fish into your net or hand if your fishing alone.
