Can you recommend a campground? We're tent campers, but would like power available at the site.

The campgrounds immediately around Gettysburg are very large (some are downright carnival like) and many don't offer tent sites. There might be some that do, but I'm not familiar with them.

About 40 min north of Gettysburg (closer to Boiling Springs) is Mountain Creek Campground, which is more remote and should be away from the crowds. There's trout fishing within walking distance.

If it were me, I'd check out two nearby state parks: Caledonia and Pine Grove Furnace. Both have tent camping but you'd have to ask about power. Caledonia is about 20 min from Gettysburg and about 40 min from Boiling Springs. Pine Grove Furnace is right down the road from Mountain Creek Campground. Both are good locations for a combo Gettysburg/fishing trip. Both these state parks have trout streams on site.
