When you were fishing the Tully this winter, especially more recently, if you fished in the Papermill area down to the Rt 222 bridge and for a few hundred yards below or above those locations, did you catch a nice mix of browns and rainbows or a large number of rainbows and only a few browns? I ask because the fall stocking in that stretch is strictly RT and the spring stockings are strictly BT.
