For the tails use a little bit of ice dubbing (black peacock) or any other similar dubbing of color and make a little dubbing ball at the end of the hook shank right before the curve. Tie in one biot at a time on the side of the shank not the top. Make sure the contour of the biot is facing out. Then simply tie in the other side to equal length. The dubbing ball will push the tails out as you tie closer to the ball. Hope this helps....practice and repetition is key as noted above.
