My question is, is the depth/flow(as well as the potential crowds) on the YB from the confluence with the "run" down to a little way below the Allenberry dam sufficient to swing streamers and soft hackle wets on a light two-hander?

Yep, you'll do fine. YB is decent water for swinging wets and streamers and I have used a switch rod there and it works well (trees are generally high above the water). The reg section of YB is likely to be crowded on weekends. If you like swinging wets and using a two hand rod, I'd avoid Big Spring or the other CV limestoneers as they are not well suited to your methods IMO.
