I was inartfully attempting to show varying degrees of slack that can be in the line and leader while nymphing. Lots of slack can mean less drag, but you will rarely detect a hit. This seems to me to be the reason people like to fish with bobber-indicators, because slack above the indicator become less significant and it is easier to control slack below if you are experienced using the float.
