-attach tippet to the hook bend

-attach to the eye of first fly's hook eye

-Tie a tippet ring at end of tippet. tie 6" for dropper, 12"-18 for anchor

-tie in anchor fly first, complete double/tripple surgeon knot above the anchor

I think the best thing about having two separate lines is the amount of movement that the fly can then perform. IF you tie just off of the hook bend the lower fly can move freely but the top fly may have its movement constricted.

hmm.

tippet to hook bend? I would suggest always taking tippet to first fly hook eye. because otherwise . . . what?
