March crappie angling has a very specific pattern on many lakes. Fish the coves into which the wind is blowing and windy days are often the best days. Additionally, the fish may not start biting until about 7PM DST (6PM EST before the clock change) and often continue until 9 PM or so. If the coves have weed beds about 3 ft below the surface, all the better. Just fish over the weeds. If there aren't any weeds, I would still recommend paying attention to the pattern that I have described. There are biological and limnological explanations for this, but I'm not going to get into them.
