Stocking not the problem as it was not significantly different from past years in terms of # fish, floats, etc. I have done much better on streams with rainbows, maybe cause its been so cold. Those Clark browns don't hit well till it warms a tad.

I suspect those fish are semi starved as there is little bug life evident. Probably everything they think is food has a hook in it.

In good years the fish stay in normal lies but this year most migrated to the downed trees that are almost unfishable. They were not stocked that way.

In any event, stocking alone does not give the fish / mile that is really desired. Better once it warms and the wilds, holdovers, and new arrivals all put the feed bags on.
