Yeah, I use an Orvis pair when I wet wade. They ran \$10 or \$15 I think.

They DON'T keep your feet dry. Were not intended to. And you should not wear socks underneath or they will just be waterlogged.

They do keep debris out. They do make the sizing fit, as you probably bought the boots for "with waders", and they'd be too big "without waders". The socks make them fit as if you had waders on. Neoprene is also a little more cushion than most socks will give you, and less likely to rub your feet raw than a sock would do.
