The size does not matter to the rod casting except if it is too heavy to cast. Example your rod with a medium fast action could cast medium size bass flies such as Clousers with the dumbbell eyes. It could also cast a size 24 Trico with out any problem. Fishing a very small fly may be a little problem with setting the hook and breaking them off due to a very light tippet. Also it is easier to present a small fly in low clear water without a disturbance with a lighter weight line. Many years ago we had rods called c instead of a 6 weight and there were not many lighter weights that I can recall.
