Like Paco said stay away from floating line all together. I do not even own one anymore. Even the topwater stuff we use the intermediate. You get a better chug with the topwater with the intermediate. This is how Brad Bohlen is usually doing it too. THE best line we have used so far is the airflo 40+ sniper. Thats what I am using for both intermediate and heavy sinking (type 7). The SA Streamer Express lines are nice but coil like a SOB even in warmer temps and they always seem to crack on me. You could also just change the head on your RIO since you have one rod and one reel. I have several so I have a reel dedicated to a rod and will have both strung up depending on water conditions.
