Here is a list of very good nymph and streamer choices for most trout waters in SE PA.

Hares Ear nymph #12 - #16

Prince nymph #12 - #16

Pheasant Tail nymph #12 - #18

Copper John nymph #14 - #18

Coachman wet fly #14

Any black stonefly #12 - #14

Any brown stonefly #12 - #14

Black Woolly Buzzer #6 - #10

Olive " " #6 - #10

White marabou #6 - #10

Glo-bugs (imitates fish eggs) #12 - #16

That's eleven subsurface flies that will catch you plenty of PA trout. If you shop around you can buy all of these flies for less than \$40.00.
