*The largest numbers of flies are still the black stone, brown stone, and brown caddis in medium brown and a ginger brown. We've seen a few Quill Gordons, some Hendricksons, red quills, and March Browns - these hatches are still very light. The blue quill is present and seems to have been more abundant on Slate and Cedar. An angler was in the shop today who caught a small brownie on the surface with a black caddis (probably taken for a black stone fly). Light and dark midges are also abundant. Best activity is middle to late afternoon. And, the flies appear to be a larger size again this year.*
