the studded vibrams are clearly much better than felts on the didymo issue... maybe the grip on rocks is not as good, I have used both, and I dont recall such a great difference. you have to watch the felts on smooth muddy stream banks, and the studded vibrams on smooth bedrock.

but with studded vibrams and a wading staff, you'd have both better stability and less didymo spread than with felts and no wading staff.

the trekking poles that stores like eastern mountain sports sell make great lightweight wading staffs... if you hike to fish, you can hike further and faster with a pair of them than just walking with nothing.

btw, a staff or trekking pole may be more important on a small stream than a big one... take a spill on a bigger stream, you may hit water, on a smaller stream, you may hit rocks.
